

ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS: ATLANTE AND GROUPE DUVAL JOIN FORCES TO DEPLOY FRANCE'S FIRST NEXT-GENERATION ULTRA-FAST CHARGING STATION COMBINING PHOTOVOLTAICS AND ENERGY STORAGE

This next-generation station, equipped with a unique energy storage capacity, will be more autonomous and more responsible from an energy standpoint.

Paris, 16 December 2025 – Atlante, key player in fast and ultra-fast charging across Southern Europe, is partnering with Groupe Duval, a French purpose-driven company committed to territorial transformation, to inaugurate France's first charging station equipped with photovoltaic panels and an energy storage system, located within the Salaise-sur-Sanne retail hub (Isère).

This ultra-fast station contributes concretely to energy independence. Equipped with photovoltaic canopies and a battery energy storage system (BESS), it leverages Atlante's proprietary energy management system to control the production, storage, and distribution of electricity in real time. The system ensures 100% green, local, and high-performance charging for electric vehicle drivers.

A first of its kind in France, this project embodies innovation serving the energy transition and illustrates the shared commitment of Atlante and Groupe Duval to making sustainable mobility accessible to all.

1,022 solar panels and energy storage: towards self-sufficient EV charging stations

The station is equipped with eight ultra-fast charging points (up to 300 kW), sheltered under four photovoltaic canopies hosting with **1,022 solar panels**, covering a total surface area of more than **2,200 square meters**, the size of over eight tennis courts.

Installed above parking and charging spaces, these panels ensure optimal solar production throughout the year. With a total capacity of **460 kWp**, the installation is expected to generate approximately **550MWh** of electricity per year, the equivalent of around **20,000 full EV charges** (based on an average consumption of 30kWh per charge), from 100% renewable energy produced on-site.

Most of the electricity required to power the charging points comes from this local solar production. When production is insufficient, the **387kWh energy storage system** takes over, allowing the station to operate in complete autonomy for up to one hour, even when several chargers are used simultaneously.

Beyond its backup function, this system is integrated within an intelligent energy ecosystem: the battery stores excess solar energy produced during the day, maximizing self-consumption and reducing reliance on the national grid. Surplus energy is reinjected into the grid, contributing to a greener, more sustainable French energy mix.

If additional energy is needed, the station draws 100% certified green electricity from the grid, with all flows managed seamlessly by Atlante's energy management system.

Turning retail hubs into strategic EV charging locations

Located just off the A7 motorway exit, in the heart of a retail area home to La Foir'Fouille, Kiloutou and Gedimat, the station reflects the synergy between Atlante, Groupe Duval and retail partners. This commercial site is undergoing a major environmental transformation, with 30% of its surfaces being renatured – a flagship project

certified BiodiverCity, illustrating Groupe Duval's commitment, through its subsidiary SEPRIC, to biodiversity and the energy transition.

By combining fast charging, energy storage, and photovoltaic production, Atlante is transforming commercial zones into true intelligent energy hubs – enhancing customer experience while creating value for retailers and local communities. This integrated approach demonstrates how sustainable energy infrastructure can coexist with economic activity, making clean mobility practical, accessible, and a driver of local growth.

A shared vision for sustainable mobility

For Atlante and Groupe Duval, this project represents far more than a new facility: it marks a **step forward toward a greener, more autonomous energy model**. It reflects both companies' commitment to accelerating the energy transition and making clean mobility simpler and more accessible, in France and across Europe.
