



## **Renexia Recharge and Atlante strengthen the electric charging network in the heart of Italy along the A24 and A25 motorways**

**20 charging points already active across three Service Areas, with 8 more coming in the next months, capable of delivering ultra-fast charging thanks to an innovative energy storage system**

Rome, 21 April 2026 - **Renexia Recharge**, a Toto Group company specialising in sustainable mobility, and Atlante, a leading European operator in the development and management of fast and ultra-fast charging infrastructure, are strengthening the rollout of electric mobility along the A24 and A25 motorways through a joint project that consolidates both companies' presence along a strategic corridor in Central Italy.

With this initiative, Atlante further expands its footprint across the Italian motorway network, where it is already present with 17 stations – operational, under activation or under construction – along key routes such as the A1 (Milan–Naples), A13 (Bologna–Padua), A14 (Adriatic), A23 (Palmanova–Tarvisio), A26 (Genoa–Gravellona Toce) and A27 (Venice–Belluno), as well as along Milan's ring roads (A50 and A51).

The project has led to the installation of **20 fast and ultra-fast charging points** across three strategic Service Areas on the A24 motorway: **Civita Sud**, just past the Lazio–Abruzzo border for those travelling from Rome; **Civita Nord** for traffic in the opposite direction; and **Valle Aterno Ovest**, near the main motorway exit for L'Aquila. In the coming months, a **further 8 charging points** are expected to be activated in another Service Area along the A25 motorway, further expanding coverage along a key route for mobility in Central Italy.

*“Renexia Recharge's commitment to strengthening the charging network along a vital road infrastructure for the country, for the Capital and for the entire Abruzzo region continues,”* said **Riccardo Toto, General Manager of Renexia**. *“With the opening of these three stations and the one that will soon be connected, we aim to actively promote low-emission mobility in a region where important industrial hubs and tourist attractions coexist with landscapes of extraordinary environmental value. All sites have been designed to grow and be progressively upgraded in line with evolving demand.”*

*“With these new stations, we are strengthening a collaboration that brings together two industrial excellences sharing the same vision: putting EV drivers at the centre and making a concrete contribution to the evolution of electric mobility in Italy. Together with Renexia Recharge, we are deploying high-performance infrastructure along the A24 and A25, designed to deliver a simple, fast and reliable charging experience along a strategic corridor for the country. The integration of advanced technological solutions, such as our proprietary EnergyArk storage system, enables ultra-fast power delivery and makes charging increasingly efficient and sustainable. It is through partnerships like this that we can support the market in reaching a more mature stage, accelerating the energy transition and making electric travel a natural choice for a growing number of drivers,”* said **Gabriele Tuccillo, CEO of Atlante Italy and Switzerland**.

The expansion of the network reflects a shared vision: **integrating electric charging into the travel experience**, turning stops into a simple, fast and sustainable moment along one of the main routes connecting the Tyrrhenian and Adriatic corridors. This infrastructure axis crosses areas of outstanding environmental value, with **three National Parks** and **three Regional Natural Parks** in close proximity, and is managed by **Strada dei Parchi SpA**, whose very name reflects the uniqueness of the context in which it operates.



The new stations will enable electric vehicles to carry out **ultra-fast charging**, restoring driving range in just a few minutes, in line with the needs of modern mobility. In this initial phase, **fast** charging is already available, with **up to 100kW**; once the storage systems are operational, the stations will be able to deliver **up to 360kW (ultra-fast)**.

Each site will be equipped with **EnergyArk**, the energy storage system designed and developed by Atlante's parent company, **TCC Group Holdings**, engineered to ensure high safety standards and operational performance, optimising energy flows and helping reduce the impact on the electricity grid.

With this new development, **Renexia Recharge and Atlante** take a further step in building a reliable, technologically advanced charging infrastructure fully integrated into the territory, **making electric travel along the A24 and A25 motorways increasingly accessible, seamless and natural for all.**
