## ATLANTE AND COOP ATLANTIQUE JOIN FORCES TO ACCELERATE THE DEPLOYMENT OF FASTCHARGING FOR ELECTRIC VEHICLES, FOR AN EVER-SMOOTHER CUSTOMER EXPERIENCE

**Paris / Saintes, April 14th, 2026** – Atlante, leading player in EV fast and ultra-fast charging, powered 100% by renewable energy, and COOP Atlantique, France’s leading consumer cooperative and a member of Coopérative U, announce the signing of a strategic partnership aimed at deploying charging infrastructure across the parking areas of a large majority of stores operated by COOP Atlantique.

### **A shared DNA serving sustainable mobility at the best price**

With strong local roots, COOP Atlantique operates a network of stores under the Hyper U, Super U, and U Express brands, mainly located in the Centre-West of France. Committed to supporting customers in the evolution of their mobility habits and enhancing their in-store experience, the company has made the strategic choice to transform its parking areas into benchmark charging hubs. This choice naturally led to Atlante, as both entities share a common commitment to the energy transition and to tangible environmental and social responsibility.

The framework agreement provides for the deployment of fast and ultra-fast charging stations across at least thirty sites, with power levels reaching up to 600kW.

The project also includes, across a large portion of sites, the deployment of EnergyArk solution, the proprietary energy storage system developed by Atlante’s parent company, TCC Group Holdings, to boost charging power. Thanks to this technology Atlante will deliver ultra-fast charging for optimal customer experience while ensuring a responsible and more sustainable approach to use of grid power. The first sites will be commissioned before the end of 2026.

The shared commitment of Coop Atlantique and Atlante is also to offer a service at a discounted, highly competitive price, positioning themselves as leaders in terms of pricing as well.

### **A pioneering approach in food retail**

COOP Atlantique is thus positioning itself among the very first food retail players in France to undertake such a large-scale and structured deployment of electric charging infrastructure. The chosen approach goes beyond simply installing charging stations: it is based on a comprehensive vision of the customer journey, where charging naturally integrates with shopping time.

For EV drivers, the value proposition is immediate: charging their vehicle while shopping, and the combination of ultra-fast chargers and EnergyArk storage system ensures optimal availability, even during peak hours.

For Atlante, this partnership fully aligns with its development strategy in the retail sector. Large retail parking areas represent prime locations for fastcharging: at the heart of local communities and generating regular traffic, they offer ideal conditions for integrating charging into daily routines. The framework agreement with COOP Atlantique marks a key milestone in this trajectory.
