From the Dolomites to the world's #1 spot, Alpitronic's powerful, reliable and beautiful chargers serve millions of EV drivers in Europe, and many corners of the world, from Australia to the USA. - **Christian Hahn for Hsubject – Ecosystem-Enabling Players Award**
