
Atlante and the Municipality of Montalcino Break Ground on an Ultra-Fast Charging Station in the Heart of Tuscany

Montalcino, May 30, 2026 – Atlante, a leading player in the fast and ultra-fast electric vehicle charging sector, today celebrated with the **Municipality of Montalcino** the groundbreaking ceremony for a new charging station.

The ceremony was attended by **Silvio Franceschelli, Mayor of Montalcino and Senator of the Italian Republic**, and **Stefano Terranova, CEO of Atlante**, who officially launched construction works with a handshake and the laying of the foundation stone for a project aimed at making the town a model of sustainable mobility in the region.

Located at the entrance to the municipality, the station will feature **eight ultra-fast charging points** with chargers delivering up to **600kW** of power, a cutting-edge solution designed to ensure minimal charging times and a seamless user experience. The site will also be equipped with an **energy storage system** that will optimize energy flow management, enabling the delivery of high charging power without placing additional strain on the national electricity grid. This innovative solution will also help stabilize peak demand and provide flexibility services to the grid.

The new station forms part of Atlante's broader European network expansion plan, in which energy storage systems play a strategic role in enabling the widespread adoption of ultra-fast charging through efficient, sustainable infrastructure powered by **100% renewable energy**.

Equipped with ultra-high-power charging infrastructure, the station represents a strategic asset in supporting a growing demand for zero-emission tourism. The availability of ultra-fast charging points will enable visitors to explore and experience Tuscany while contributing to the preservation and enhancement of the natural and landscape heritage that makes this area unique.

The initiative is part of a broader effort to enhance the value of Tuscan territory. Montalcino, renowned worldwide for its winemaking heritage and tourism appeal, is a strategic hub within the regional road network. Atlante's decision to invest in this location reflects its commitment to supporting zero-emission tourism in an area of exceptional scenic value. It is no coincidence that the agreement was officially announced during the **Eroica**, the iconic cycling event that shares Atlante's values of **clean mobility** and **sustainability**, reaffirming the company's commitment to promoting every form of sustainable transportation, from two wheels to four.

The project will also strengthen the electric mobility infrastructure network across southern Tuscany, making the region increasingly accessible to national and international traffic flows and reinforcing Montalcino's role as a leader in sustainable innovation, capable of combining high-quality services, local development, and environmental protection.

"The construction of this new electric vehicle charging station marks an important step forward in the sustainable innovation journey undertaken by our territory. Thanks to the agreement with Atlante, it has been possible to develop an area that would otherwise have been inaccessible, launching a significant urban regeneration project and enhancing the surrounding environment. Montalcino once again demonstrates its commitment to the recovery of public spaces, landscape protection, and environmental sustainability. Investing in modern and sustainable infrastructure also means strengthening the quality of hospitality and the competitiveness of the territory. This station will provide a tangible service for citizens, businesses, and visitors, helping to make southern Tuscany increasingly connected to the evolving needs of electric mobility," said **Mayor Silvio Franceschelli**.

"This station is among the first ever designed by Atlante. In a landscape of such extraordinary beauty, every new development must be carefully assessed by the relevant authorities, whom I would like to thank for approving our project. Tuscany is among the Italian regions with the highest sales of electric vehicles, making it an important area for Atlante's presence. In addition to providing an essential service for local residents, this station is designed to serve the many tourists who visit the region. Suffice it to say that around 60% of international tourism in Italy chooses Tuscany as its destination. Montalcino, in particular, is world-famous for the beauty of its historic town and the prestige of its vineyards, home to the renowned Brunello wine. Finally, being present here, in the heart of the

roads that host L'Eroica, perfectly reflects our mission: integrating ultra-fast charging innovation while respecting the beauty and traditions of territories that are unique in the world," said **Stefano Terranova, CEO of Atlante**.
