

Atlante launches the largest ultra-fast charging network for electric vehicles in Galicia region

- Together with the O Burgo station inaugurated today and already serving customers, the region will soon see the opening of the San Simón station.
- The new facilities in O Burgo and San Simón will bring the total number of ultra-fast charging points in the region to 32, consolidating a strategic charging network along the AP-9 highway.

O Burgo (A Coruña), 15 July 2026 - Atlante inaugurated today a new ultra-fast charging stations for electric vehicles in **O Burgo** (A Coruña) which will soon be followed by a second one in **San Simón** (Pontevedra), both located in service areas along the Autopista del Atlántico (AP-9) highway. With a total of **32 ultra-fast charging points** - 16 at each site - the project constitutes Galicia's largest ultra-fast charging network in terms of number of points and represents a new boost to the development of electric mobility on one of the main traffic corridors in the north-west of the Iberic peninsula.

The opening ceremony was presided over by the **Spanish Minister for Industry and Tourism, Jordi Hereu**. Also in attendance were **the Government Delegate in Galicia; Pedro Blanco, Deputy Government Delegate in A Coruña; Julio Abalde, the Regional Minister for the Presidency, Justice and Sport of the Xunta de Galicia, Diego Calvo Pouso, the Director-General for Energy Planning and Mines, Pablo Fernández Vila, the Chair of the Committee on Industry, Employment and Demographic Policy of the Provincial Council of A Coruña, Rosa Ana García; and the Mayor of Culleredo, José Ramón Rioboo Castro**. Atlante was represented by **Stefano Terranova, CEO of Atlante**, and **Quim Ibern, CEO of Atlante Spain**.

Atlante designed, installed and commissioned and will operate both stations, which have been created to meet the increase in electric mobility for both long-distance journeys and local and metropolitan travel. The project forms part of the electrification strategy promoted by AUDASA with the aim of strengthening the electric mobility infrastructure on the AP-9 highway.

The location of O Burgo and San Simon stations, at two strategic points along the Atlantic corridor, will improve charging coverage for the over 50,000 vehicles that use the AP-9 on these sections every day. With this roll-out, Atlante is expanding its presence in Galicia and contributing to the development of a charging network capable of meeting the growth in electric vehicle use, in line with the objectives of energy transition, the roll-out of alternative fuel infrastructure and the decarbonisation of transport promoted by Spain and the European Union.

During the opening ceremony, **Quim Ibern, CEO of Atlante Spain**, emphasised that the presence of these stations marks a milestone for the development of electric mobility in Galicia: *"The launch of these two stations represents a decisive step towards facilitating electric mobility in Galicia. We want to offer drivers a fast, simple and reliable charging experience at strategic locations, removing barriers and supporting the growth of electric vehicles with high-quality infrastructure"*.

Stefano Terranova, CEO of Atlante, emphasised that: *"The real challenge is no longer whether transport will electrify, but whether we can build the infrastructure quickly enough to support this transformation. Projects like the AP-9 charging network demonstrate how strategic investment, combined with the long-term vision of public institutions and private partners, can create lasting value for territories, businesses and citizens alike. I would like to sincerely thank the national, regional and local authorities for their foresight and commitment, which have been instrumental in turning this vision into reality".*

Minister Jordi Hereu highlighted the significance of the inauguration of this EV charging station, emphasizing the importance of expanding the charging network as part of the mobility transformation strategy that the Government and the industry are advancing together.

The Minister encouraged stakeholders to continue *"installing more charging points across the country,"* making electric mobility increasingly accessible while continuing to support the development of the automotive industry of the future.

The presence of Atlante stations makes the AP-9 one of the main ultra-fast charging corridors in north-western Spain and reinforces the company's commitment to developing infrastructure capable of accelerating the transition to zero-emission mobility.
